Dear Friends,

We are pleased you have decided to apply for a scholarship. The Presbyterian Church believes education is important, and we are glad to be a part of so many people's lives in this way. We are the recipients of generous church members who have given so much so that others may receive. To be the recipient of a scholarship is a great privilege.

The scholarships offered at the First Presbyterian Church have been applied for by many students. We cannot promise that each person who applies will receive a scholarship: it is incorrect to assume that a scholarship is guaranteed because one is a church member. The amounts awarded vary due to the money available each year and the nature of the criteria of the scholarship.

The Scholarship Committee has a difficult choice of selecting those who should receive the awards. There are many qualified applicants; the decision is based on the information you provide on the application form.

The following is required to insure that your application will be considered for the various scholarships:

- 1. The application provided by First Presbyterian Church MUST be used.
- 2. Application forms will be available in the church office and online at: fpcfd.org/information/scholarship-applications/ on February 1st.
- 3. Be sure the application is COMPLETE and LEGIBLE. Incomplete or improperly completed forms WILL NOT be considered. Be sure to read the application over when completed. Double check that it is complete!
- 4. Applications must be in THE CHURCH OFFICE by 1:00 pm on April 1st. Applications turned in after that time will not be accepted.
- 5. Applicants WILL NOT be notified of any errors in their submissions. The applicant alone is responsible for the content of their application.
- 6. Include ALL information requested: a biographical sketch, involvement in the church, and church related activities.
- 7. A current letter (less than a year old) of recommendation from a school instructor or an employer. Do not ask a pastor, church staff member or member of the First Presbyterian Church Congregation.
- 8. Include a transcript of grades.
- 9. Scholarships will be announced at a designated Sunday morning worship, and will be awarded at class night for your school. A letter will be sent in May regarding the amount of scholarship money you will receive.
- 10. We will list names of the scholarship recipients in the church bulletin and the newsletter.
- 11. Please contact Amy Conlon for any of the following changes: Home or College address change; name change; and/or a change in schools or your enrollment status. The deadlines to communicate these changes are: 1st semester by July 15th; 2nd semester by December 1st.
