### Scripture: Romans 10:12-17 (The Message)

<sup>11-13</sup> Scripture reassures us, "No one who trusts God like this—heart and soul—will ever regret it." It's exactly the same no matter what a person's religious background may be: the same God for all of us, acting the same incredibly generous way to everyone who calls out for help. "Everyone who calls, 'Help, God!' gets help."

<sup>14-17</sup> But how can people call for help if they don't know who to trust? And how can they know who to trust if they haven't heard of the One who can be trusted? And how can they hear if nobody tells them? And how is anyone going to tell them, unless someone is sent to do it? That's why Scripture exclaims,

A sight to take your breath away!

Grand processions of people

telling all the good things of God!

But not everybody is ready for this, ready to see and hear and act. Isaiah asked what we all ask at one time or another: "Does anyone care, God? Is anyone listening and believing a word of it?" The point is: Before you trust, you have to listen. But unless Christ's Word is preached, there's nothing to listen to.

## Let's Talk About It......

Once Mister Rogers said, "When I was a boy and I would do scary things in the news, my mother would say to me, 'Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."

When I see people helping one another, it makes me feel so happy and hopeful. In Scripture, God is described as our ultimate helper. When we need help or comfort, we know we can pray to God for guidance, help, and comfort. The scripture we heard and read today shows us that people who may not know scripture or know that God is our helper might not know who they can call. This is why we need to tell our stories but also why we need to be active helpers in the world.
